

## CLC Licence (conveyancing) - Candidates with a Law Degree obtained outside England and Wales wishing to apply for exemptions

To be entitled to exemption from the equivalent units on the **Conveyancing Law and Practice Diploma Level 4** candidates who have achieved a Law Degree outside England and Wales,
provided it is based on a jurisdiction derived from English common law, must provide evidence
that as part of their Law Degree they have **PASSED** units equivalent to:

- 1. The English Legal System
- 2. Law of Contract
- 3. English Land Law

AND, candidates **MUST** also ensure their knowledge of the English conveyancing law and process meets the CLC's standard for Education and Training and **PASS** the remaining two units at level 4

- 4. Standard Conveyancing Transactions
- 5. Understanding Accounting Procedures for Conveyancing Transactions

**BEFORE** being able to progress onto and **PASS** the **Conveyancing Law and Practice Diploma Level 6**.

## CLC Licence (probate) - Candidates with a Law Degree obtained outside England and Wales wishing to apply for exemptions

To be entitled to exemption from the equivalent units on the **Probate Law and Practice Diploma Level 4** candidates who have achieved a Law Degree outside England and Wales, provided it is based on a jurisdiction derived from English common law, must provide evidence that as part of their Law Degree they have **PASSED** units equivalent to:

- 1. The English Legal System
- 2. Law of Contract
- 3. English Land Law

AND candidates **MUST** also ensure their knowledge of the English probate law and process meets the CLC's standard for Education and Training and **PASS** the remaining two units at Level 4.

- 4. Law of Wills, Succession and Grants of Representation
- 5. Understanding Accounting Procedures for Probate Transactions
