




Instructions Week 2




Instructions Week 3




Scale of change Week 1




Scale of change Week 2




Scale of change Week 3




Remote working Week 1


Remote working Week 2


Are the majority of staff in your firm currently working remotely or from your office?



Does the business's current financial position mean that you are considering temporary or permanent closure, redundancies, unpaid leave or restructuring or any other measures? (Tick all that apply.)



What steps (if any) have you already taken in response to the impact of the coronavirus on your business? (Tick all that apply.)








