Probate

BEFORE being able to progress onto and **PASS** the Probate Law and Practice Diploma Level 6

To be entitled to exemption from the equivalent units on the **Probate Law and Practice Diploma Level 4** candidates who have achieved a Law Degree outside England and Wales, provided it is based on a jurisdiction derived from English common law. AND candidates **MUST** also ensure their knowledge of the English probate law and process meets the CLC's standard for Education and Training and **PASS** the below unit at Level 4.

1. Law of Wills, Succession and Grants of Representation

Occupational Experience

All first qualifying Licence applicants must also complete and submit with their application a **Statement of Practical Experience (SoPE)**, for 1200 hours work experience gained in relevant workplace setting. A SoPE must be signed and verified by an Authorised Person; such as a CLC, SRA or CILEx Lawyer, with the appropriate practise rights and a current and valid licence.
