

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR A FCILEX CONVERSION TO CLC LAWYER APPLICATION:

- a) Your CILEx Practising Certificate number
- b) A copy of you FCILEx Practising Certificate
- c) Evidence of your past full years completed CPD, including dates and topics
- d) Current CV
- e) A certified copy of either: -
 - 1. Your CILEx Membership Certificate listing your exam specialisms; OR
 - 2. Your CILEx Practitioner Certificate

*Certifications on your certificates must be dated and signed by an authorised person and include their signature, printed name and practising certificate number.

When you are not able to provide evidence for category e) above, to demonstrate that you have recent and valid occupational experience, please provide <u>one</u> of the following:

- f) Evidence of being currently authorised as a CLC HoLP or SRA COLP in a conveyancing and/or probate practice
- g) A letter of appointment from your current employer
- h) A letter from your current employer confirming your dates of appointment
- i) A completed and verified CLC Statement of Practical Experience (1200 hours) for Conveyancing and/or Probate (follow or copy and paste this link into your browser: https://www.clc-uk.org/practical-experience/)
