Summary

This paper sets out proposals for consultation on changes to the CLC's regime to promote ongoing competence in the regulated community through changes to Continuing Professional Development.

Regulatory Objectives

The proposals set out in this paper are intended to support the following regulatory objectives.

- RO1 protect and promote the public interest
- RO4 protect and promote the interests of consumers
- RO6 encourage an independent, strong, diverse and effective legal profession
- RO8 promote and maintain adherence to the professional principles

Recommendations

Council is asked to agree that the CLC should consult on changes to Continuing Professional Development on the basis set out in this paper.
