Summary

This report sets out proposed amendments to the CLC's Publication Policy following discussion at the September Workshop meeting.

Recommendations

- 1) The Council is asked to agree amendments to the Publication Policy to make clear that
 - a) Individuals may request access to Council Papers in advance of meetings
 - b) Individuals may attend Council Meetings as an observer for specific items
- 2) The Council is also asked to agree that arrangements should be made for an annual open meeting of the Council.

Relevant Regulatory Objectives

Transparency of decision-making and the work of the CLC in general engages with the following Regulatory Objectives.

- RO1 protect and promote the public interest
- RO2 support the constitutional principle of the rule of law
- RO4 protect and promote the interests of consumers
- RO6 encourage an independent, strong, diverse and effective legal profession
- RO7 increase public understanding of the citizen's legal rights and duties
- RO8 promote and maintain adherence to the professional principles

Financial impact

An annual open meeting of the Council will entail some expense. We will aim to minimise this by aligning the meeting with the CLC conference that is planned for Autumn 2022.
