Summary

The Adjudication Panel makes disciplinary determinations and hears appeals against regulatory decisions of the CLC. The Adjudication Panel comprises of Lay and Professional Members who are independent of the CLC.

The Adjudication Panel Chair provided a written Annual Report to the Council's meeting on 27 July 2023 and is attending this Council meeting to meet with members and provide an overview of the Panel's work in 2022/2023.

- 6. promote and maintain adherence to the professional principles
